Learning in individual art forms as well as in multi-arts experiences engages and strengthens such fundamental cognitive capabilities as spatial reasoning (the capacity for organizing and sequencing ideas); conditional reasoning (theorizing about outcomes and consequences); problem solving; and the components of creative thinking (originality, elaboration, flexibility).

Motivation and the attitudes and dispositions to pursue and sustain learning are essential to achievement. Learning in the arts nurtures these capacities – active engagement, disciplined and sustained attention, persistence and risk-taking – and increases attendance and education aspirations.
